Project Summary

San Luis had a different category of project: they asked for school supplies, which also included a printer-copier for the use of the students and teachers.

This year, they have 45 kids enrolled from kindergarten to sixth grade. There are two teachers paid by the Government (Prof. Elsira Vasquez Diaz and Prof. Maria Emma Melgar). The teacher for kindergarten is usually paid by the Municipality of San Marcos de la Sierra. They're not sure if they will continue hiring her the 2018 school year.

As you will be able to notice I added the list of school supplies that we bought for the school. The most expensive item was the printer-copier (L.4,900.00), almost half of their budget. The majority of the school supplies were delivered on the 31st of October on a parents meeting. The teachers requested to have printer-copier delivered before the end of the school year since that's when they need it to print out students' certificates and school reports for the Secretaria de Educacion.

The only thing missing on that delivery was extra ink for the printer since the store which carries it ran out of it. We purchased it later on and went back to the school when they were back in session.

The teachers and parents were very thankful for such help. They say many of the advantages of having a copier-printer at the school is that parents won't have to spend additional money so the teachers that live in La Esperanza could make copies or print out stuff for the kid's school files or classwork.

This community didn't spend the entire Lps. 10,000.00. The remaining funds will be saved to add to any future project that is approved for the benefit of their community.
